My Story: I started drumming at age 2. I drummed on EVERYTHING and EVERYWHERE possible. I joined a DRUM CIRCLE at age 8 and realized more drums were needed for the community. I raised my first \$380 to fund a stackable set of 3 Remo drums. (They're still in use today!) With the help of Coastal Music & Arts Foundation, I went on to raise \$980 for additional percussion instruments. We now have 5 hand drums, 2 dozen shakers, an assortment of 20 other percussion instruments and 14 bucket drums with Remo heads that are in use throughout North County. I have visions of hosting drum making workshops, drum circles in senior centers and eventually creating a program to aid high risk youths through music and community engagement.
